We currently manage and operate the largest and youngest fleet of AgustaWestland 109 GrandNew helicopters in the UK. We hold a single pilot IFR EASA AOC (GB 2420) to operate the AW 109 and the AS 350 throughout the UK, Ireland and Europe.

Presently we have three main operating bases in the UK. Carlisle Lake District Airport, in the North West which is where our head office is located, London Southend Airport in the South East where we operate in partnership with Stobart Exec Jet Centre to provide transfers for business and private passengers into and out of London, and Cardiff City Heliport in the South West where we are the only operator of VVIP helicopters in Wales.

We are a dedicated team who work together to provide a first-class service by offering seamless door to door executive travel solutions for the discerning family, celebrity, business person or royalty. It goes without saying, that this exceptional service comes with complete anonymity and discretion for all our clients.

2 London Southend Airport *Stobart* Exec Jet Centre

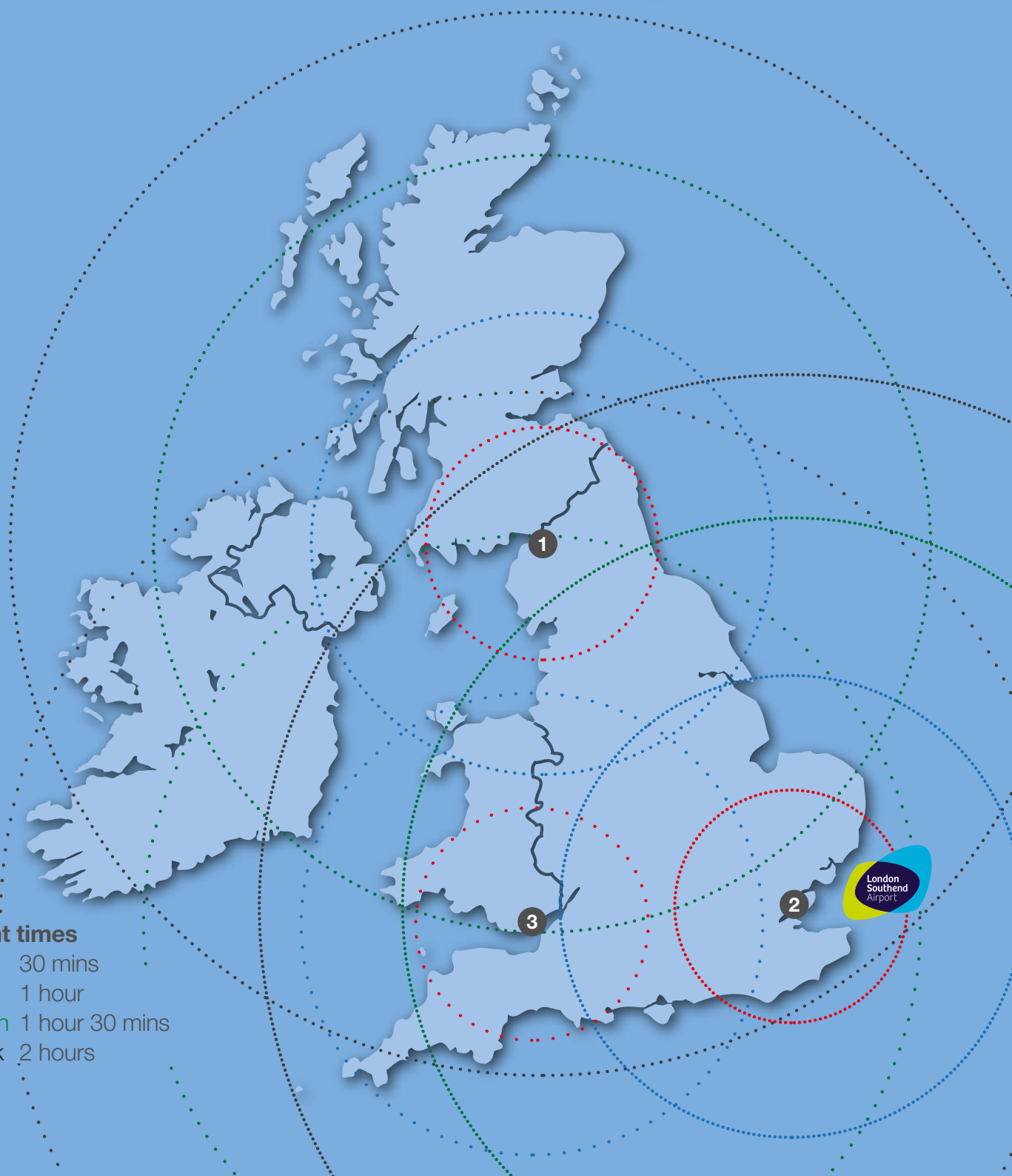
